

28-DAYS OF PRAYER



Week 1 – Vision, Gospel Foundation, and Calling

Day 1 – God’s Glory in the Ministry

Pray that Kingdom Kids would exist first and foremost for the glory of God and for Jesus Christ to be exalted.

Day 2 – Gospel-Centered Teaching

Pray that every lesson, activity, and conversation would clearly point children to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Day 3 – A Unified Story of Scripture

Pray that children would understand the Bible as one unified story of God’s redemption from Genesis to Revelation.

Day 4 – Faith Taking Root Early

Pray that the Holy Spirit would begin a genuine work of faith in the hearts of children from a young age.

Day 5 – Partnership with Parents

Pray that Kingdom Kids would strengthen parents and encourage gospel-centered discipleship in the home.

Day 6 – Long-Term Spiritual Fruit

Pray not only for launch-day success, but for lasting fruit that remains for generations.

Day 7 – Dependence on the Holy Spirit

Pray that this ministry would be marked by dependence on the Holy Spirit rather than human effort.

Week 2 – Reaching New Families and Children

Day 8 – New Families

Pray that the Lord would draw new families with young children to Freedom Fellowship Church by His grace.

Day 9 – Openness to the Gospel

Pray that families who visit would come with open hearts, ready to hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Day 10 – First-Time Guests

Pray that first-time families would feel welcomed, seen, and loved from the moment they arrive.

Day 11 – Children Who Have Not Been Discipled

Pray for children who may have little or no exposure to God's Word, that Kingdom Kids would be a place where faith begins.

Day 12 – Parents Seeking Help and Hope

Pray for parents who are tired, overwhelmed, or searching for help in raising their children, that they would find support in the church.

Day 13 – Building Trust with New Families

Pray that new families would quickly grow to trust the church, its leaders, and those serving their children.

Day 14 – God's Mission Beyond Our Walls

Pray that Kingdom Kids would be used as an outreach tool God uses to bring new families into the life of the church.

Week 3 – Workers, Training, and Readiness

Day 15 – Servant Hearts

Pray that workers would see their service as discipleship, not babysitting.

Day 16 – Christlike Example

Pray that workers would model Christ in word, deed, and attitude before children and parents.

Day 17 – Teaching Faithfulness

Pray for faithfulness to the Gospel Project curriculum and wisdom in communicating truth clearly.

Day 18 – Joyful Classrooms

Pray that classrooms would be filled with joy, respect, structure, and warmth.

Day 19 – Worker Unity and Rotation

Pray for unity among workers and smooth scheduling that allows them to worship regularly.

Day 20 – Protection and Integrity

Pray for background checks, safety policies, and accountability to be honored with integrity.

Day 21 – Raising Future Leaders

Pray that Kingdom Kids would be a training ground for future servants and leaders in the church.

Week 4 – Preparation, Faithfulness, and God’s Timing

Day 22 – Readiness Before Growth

Pray that the church would be spiritually and practically ready before God brings families through the doors.

Day 23 – Safety and Trustworthiness

Pray that all safety procedures, policies, and structures would honor God and build trust with future families.

Day 24 – Preparation of Spaces and Supplies
